- **Hours:** Market - 3:00-7:00 pm & Vendor Set Up - 2:00-3:00 pm
- **Location:** Mountain Bay Plaza. There is room for 20 stalls with 12' width. Vendors must check in at the Pulaski Area Chamber of Commerce booth each week.
- **Cancellation Notification:** In case of inclement weather, a cancellation notification will be emailed to all expected vendors by 1:00 pm on the day of the market. The cancellation will also be available on our Facebook page.

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Policies & Procedures

Becoming a Vendor: Mail Vendor Application and Payment to: Pulaski Area Chamber of Commerce (PACC)

Vendor Fee:

4 Weeks: \$32.00 (\$8/week)

8 Weeks: \$56.00 (\$7/week)

Full Season (16 Weeks): \$96.00 (\$6/week)

Types of Products: We invite local growers, farmers, artisans, crafters, & entrepreneurs.

Grown and agricultural produce have been the primary interest at Markets, however, we are looking to increase sales for every local entrepreneur! In doing so, we are interested hosting a variety of products for a variety of customers.

Location & Spaces: The market will be located at the Mountain Bay Plaza. There is room for 20 stalls with 12' width. Canopies/Tents will be allowed within booth space.

Licenses, Permits, Regulations, & Taxes: Each vendor shall obtain all required licenses and permits, comply with all rules and regulations, including Dept. of Health, regarding sale of its products and collect required sales tax. State and local inspections of licenses, permits, and sales are anticipated. New vendors who have questions about licensing should contact Brown County.

Other Policies:

No Pets – Vendors shall not bring pets into the market for health and safety reasons. The sale or giving away of animals at the market is prohibited.

No Smoking – Please no smoking in or around you booth as we feel this will make a cleaner environment for all involved.

Waste – Vendors must not discard refuse of any kind in or around trash receptacles in the downtown area or market.

Vendors must clean up their sales areas completely before leaving and haul the waste away with them. Leaving the stalls with litter or refuse will be considered a violation of these rules.

Vendor Conduct: Vendors shall be courteous to others. Threatening, abusive or harassing behavior violates these rules and will result in immediate expulsion from the market for that day. A second violation will result in the vendor to be permanently barred from vending at the market. No loud or disturbing noises shall be made or action taken on the grounds that may interfere with the rights, comfort or convenience of the other vendors or the public. No Vendor shall sell from outside of their 12 x 12 space. No vendor shall play, or allow to be played, any radio or other sound equipment at a sound level that may annoy or disturb others. The running of any gasoline or diesel motors or engines, including vehicles, is not permitted. Because of the safety hazard, charcoal grills are prohibited at the market. A complaint may be submitted to the on-site manager or committee member, vendors are urged to inform the on-site manager if an infraction of these rules is witnessed. A warning and written notification of the violation will be given to the vendor at the discretion of the committee. Further violations may result in expulsion from the market, with no refund. Any Vendor whose vending rights have been terminated may appeal the determination by contacting the Pulaski Street Market Committee.

Consent to Policies & Procedures: Submission of a Vendor Application constitutes agreement to abide by these rules.
